RE: BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS, MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN AND WATER USE LICENCE APPLICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE IMPALA ZIRCON TEMPORARY BY-PASS 132KV POWERLINE WITH ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE AND THE MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPALA ZIRCON 132KV MAIN POWERLINE WITHIN THE UMHLATHUZE MUNICIPALITY IN KWAZULU-NATAL.

Eskom SOC Limited (the applicant) intends for the Maintenance and Refurbishment of the Impala Zircon 132kV Powerline which provides electricity to approximately 6062 customers; however, due to its proximity to the coast, this line is experiencing severe corrosion and deterioration. Therefore, the client is proposing to construct a temporary 6.01 km 132kV Bypass Powerline using Triple Wooden Pole Structures, which will be in use for a period of 3 years to allow for the refurbishment and maintenance of the Main Powerline. The temporary bypass will run parallel to the existing main line, approximately 15m apart from each other and across the uMhlathuze River.

The Temporary and Main Powerline Routes can be accessed along N2 and R34 Road. The coordinates to site are:

The proposed development requires Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) (Act No. 107 of 1998). This is due to the activities that will triggered in Listing Notices 1 and 3 under the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 (as amended). Therefore, a Basic Assessment process will be followed.

Furthermore, a Maintenance Management Plan (MMP) will be developed for the Refurbishment and Maintenance of the Existing Main Powerline. The MMP will be compiled in terms of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) promulgated under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), more specifically to meet the requirements of Section 28 of NEMA, which relates to the duty of care and remediation.

Lastly, a Water Use License Application (WULA) is required as the proposed development triggers Section 21 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA) and the associated Appeals Regulations, 2017 (as amended).
